


**Royal Ulster Yacht Club**  
Current Covid-19 Rules (at 30 July 2020)



**DINING:**

Dining is currently open to all members and their guests.

In order to adhere to the social distancing guidelines, we are limited to 6 people per table and can only accommodate a maximum of 2 households dining together.

The temporary dining times are as follows, however we do expect these to be extended in the near future:

LUNCH:-

Friday and Sunday 12pm to 3pm

EVENING DINING:-

Friday and Saturday 6pm to 9pm

Booking is not essential, however it is recommended as due to social distancing we are limited to a smaller number of tables available than members have been previously used to.

**BAR:**

Temporary bar opening times are:-

Friday:           12pm to 3pm  
                      5pm to 11pm

Saturday:        5pm to 11pm

Sunday:          12pm to 8pm

At this time drinks can only be purchased through a table service and must be consumed outside at the tables provided.

Outdoor tables do not have to be booked but please be aware we are limited in the amount of outdoor seating that we can provide.

Unfortunately we cannot allow drinks to be consumed indoors unless purchased as part of a main meal.

Social distancing guidelines must be adhered to on the outdoor seating areas.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The one way system throughout the club has been relaxed although we would remind members to adhere to the required social distancing at all times

We can accept applications to book the Gloucester and Lipton room and these will be considered on a case by case basis and whether we can accommodate while still adhering to the Government guidelines.

**SAILING:**

We would also remind all competitors taking part in our Round the Lough racing that adherence to Government's guidelines on social distancing is expected and is the responsibility of the owners and skippers.

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The government guidelines are constantly being updated and we are relaxing the rules as soon as we are able to so please bear with us and have patience with our staff while we navigate getting back to normality.
