Cruise Ship Visit

12th July – MV Hebridean Princess

Cruise ship Hebridean Princess is scheduled to anchor off Bangor during the morning of Thursday 12th July. Passenger will be tendered ashore to Bangor Marina. Access and egress to the tender landing sites will be governed by the Ship and Port Facility (Security) Regulations 2004. Proposed landing site – the Fuel Pontoon.

Access Restrictions – Central Pier

Due to the Hebridean Princess cruise ship visit access to vehicular traffic will be restricted

Thursday 12th July 0800 hrs – 1930 hrs

Access Restrictions – Fuel Pontoon

Due to Hebridean Princess cruise ship visit, access to the fuel pontoon and landing site on the commercial pier will be restricted. The fuel berth will remain closed for the duration.

Thursday 12th July 0800 hrs – 1930 hrs.

If the opportunity arises we will open the fuel berth for short periods of time. Access to the fuel pontoon will be strictly controlled. Please call the Marina reception in advance for permission to proceed to the fuel berth.

Any person who contravenes 'The Ship and Port Facility (Security) Regulations 2004' and gains access to the temporary restricted area without lawful authority or reasonable excuse is guilty of an offence. The P.S.N.I. will be called and D.f.T. will be informed.
